ASSESSMENT OF COSTS - REASONS

<u>Charles E. Stinson</u> Assessment Officer

[1] The Court dismissed with costs this appeal from a decision of the Federal Court concerning renewal of a lease on reserve lands. I issued a timetable for written disposition of the bill of costs of the Respondent, Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (the Crown Respondent).

[2] The Appellant did not file any materials in response to the Crown Respondent's materials. My view, often expressed in comparable circumstances, is that the *Federal Courts Rules* do not contemplate a litigant benefiting by having an assessment officer step away from a neutral position to act as the litigant's advocate in challenging given items in a bill of costs. However, the assessment officer cannot certify unlawful items, i.e. those outside the authority of the judgment and the tariff. I examined each item claimed in the amended bill of costs and the supporting materials within those parameters. The total amount claimed is generally arguable as reasonable within the limits of the award of costs and is allowed as presented at \$2,436.92.
