- [1] We were not satisfied that Justice Archambault of the Tax Court of Canada (judge) made a reviewable error in his findings of fact and law.
- [2] The evidence amply supported his finding that no business existed and the inferences of fact that he drew. It was for him to assess this evidence and the witnesses' credibility. Absent a palpable
