I. Introduction


- [1] On April 27, 2021, the appellant filed a notice of appeal with the Tax Court of Canada.
- [2] The appellant argued that a capital loss of \$141,564 resulted from a redemption. This loss was deferred in the late Georges Robillard's final return.
- [3] In the notice of assessment issued on March 30, 2016, the Minister set the amount of this capital loss at \$68,442.
- [4] At the hearing, the appellant discontinued its appeal on the issue of the \$141,564 capital loss having been deferred in the late Georges Robillard's final return.
